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Background Music Suppliers

In this form, *you, your* and *licensee* means the person or company applying for a licence or filing your report. *We, our, us* and SOCAN means the Society of Composers, Authors and Music Publishers of Canada. *Works* means any or all of the musical works in SOCAN's repertoire.

If you are applying for a licence, SOCAN will process your application within 30 days of receipt and contact you in the event that your application is not approved.

A Tariff 16 licence gives you the right to communicate to the public by telecommunication *Works* and/or authorizes a subscriber to perform such *Works* in public as background music, including any use of *Works* with a telephone on hold. This licence does not cover the use of music expressly covered in other tariffs including the SOCAN-NRCC Pay Audio Services Tariff, Tariffs 3.B (Recorded Music Accompanying Live Entertainment), 3.C (Adult Entertainment Clubs), 9 (Sports Events), 13 (Public Conveyances), 17 (Pay, Specialty and Other Television Services), 18 (Recorded Music for Dancing) or 19 (Fitness Activities and Dance Instruction).

Please contact us if you have other music uses. You may need to be licensed under other tariffs.

How to calculate your licence fee

The quarterly licence fees for the years **2007 to 2009** are based on whether you communicate *Works* to your subscribers and/or authorize subscribers to perform *Works* in public as background music including any use of *Works* with a telephone on hold.

Specifically, the quarterly licence fees are calculated as follows:

1. *Communication Right*

a supplier who communicates a *Work* during a quarter pays 2.25% of revenues from subscribers who received such a communication during the quarter, subject to a minimum fee of \$1.50 per relevant premises;

2. *Performing Right*

a supplier who authorizes a subscriber to perform in public a *Work* during a quarter pays 7.5% of revenues from subscribers so authorized during the quarter, subject to a minimum fee of \$5 per relevant premises. A supplier who authorizes a subscriber to perform in public a *Work* is not required to pay the royalties set out in (2) to the extent that the subscriber complies with SOCAN Tariff 15;

3. *Small Cable Transmission Systems*

licence fees payable by a small cable transmission system are reduced by half.

Terms of this licence

The legal terms that govern your licence include those set out herein as well as the terms found in the approved tariff including the General Provisions, as approved by the Copyright Board for each year (collectively, the *tariff*). If you have any questions regarding the terms, please contact us at the address and numbers shown at the bottom of this page.

1. If the tariff for a year has not been approved by January 1st of that year, the last approved tariff will govern until the new version is approved, at which time the licence fees will be adjusted to reflect the approved version for the year.
2. A copy of any tariff may be obtained from SOCAN by calling **1.866.944.6223**.
3. The licence fee, plus applicable taxes, will be calculated in accordance with the terms of the tariff based on the information set out in the most recently filed report form or audit form, subject to adjustment to reflect any updated reports or audits pursuant to the tariff.
4. No later than 60 days after the end of the quarter, you shall pay the licence fees for that quarter.
5. We have the right to audit your books and records, on reasonable notice during normal business hours, to verify the statements rendered and the fee payable by you.
6. SOCAN has the right to terminate this licence for any breach of the licence's terms or conditions upon 30 days notice in writing.

Reporting Requirements

7. If you communicate *Works* to a subscriber during a quarter, you shall provide with your payment the sequential lists of all musical works transmitted on the last seven days of each month of the quarter. Each entry shall mention the date and time of transmission, the title of the musical work, the name of the author and the composer of the work, the name of the performer or of the performing group, the running time, in minutes and seconds, the title of the record album, the record label, the Universal Product Code (UPC) and the International Standard Recording Code (ISRC). This information is provided only if it is available to you or to a third party from whom you are entitled to obtain the information. This information is not required with respect to any signal that is subject to the SOCAN-NRCC Pay Audio Services Tariff. Small cable transmission systems are not required to comply with these reporting requirements.
8. If you authorize a subscriber to perform in public a *Work* as background music during a quarter, you shall provide with your payment the name of each subscriber and the address of each premises for which you are making a payment.
9. Information under these reporting requirements shall be delivered electronically in plain text format or in any other format agreed upon by SOCAN and you.
10. No later than 60 days after the end of the quarter, you shall report the information used to calculate your licence fees for that quarter.
