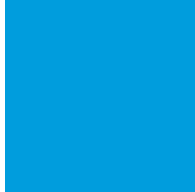
Members also benefit from SOCAN's leadership on the issues that affect composers in the protection of their intellectual property rights at home and around the world.

About Our Services

Member Services:

Member Services functions as a conduit between SOCAN and its members. Representatives of the department are responsible for the recruitment, orientation and ongoing education of members, as well as the maintenance of detailed member records. Members benefit from the personal attention and specialized knowledge of the department's representatives, who address member queries quickly and efficiently. Member Services works continually to develop and promote cost-effective, value-added services for members.

Member Relations:

Member Relations is responsible for promoting the benefits of SOCAN membership to our high-earning members and their key influencers. The department works to enhance SOCAN's presence within the music industry, both domestically and internationally, placing an emphasis on SOCAN's role as a major player. In addition, Member Relations provides educational and career development opportunities for all members and organizes events that celebrate their success. Internationally, the department advocates that SOCAN is the performing rights organization (PRO) of choice for all Canadian composers, songwriters, lyricists and music publishers.

Licensing:

Playing a vital role in the whole operation of SOCAN, this department sells music users access to virtually the world's entire repertoire of copyright-protected music for communication and public performance. The revenue from this activity allows members to be paid when their music is used.

Distribution Operations:

The Distribution Operations team delivers domestic and international performing rights royalties to our members and international affiliated organizations, in an accurate, complete and timely manner.

Legal Services

Legal Services leads SOCAN's lobbying efforts on issues that are most important to our members, and represents them on copyright and other regulatory policy matters. They have the resources to effectively defend SOCAN's interests on behalf of its membership.

Communications and Marketing:

This department ensures the reputation of SOCAN, as a leading copyright collective that champions the work of its members, is simply and efficiently articulated to all stakeholders on whom the organization's success depends, especially customers.
