Fee:
flat fee per quarter, based on seating capacity:

- Music only while on the ground – fees range from \$40.50 to \$82.50 per aircraft
- In-flight music, excluding music while on the ground – fees range from \$162.00 to \$330.00 per aircraft

Deadline:
fees are payable on Mar. 31, Jun. 30, Sept. 30, and Dec. 31 of each licensed year

0-100	\$162.00
101-160	\$205.20
161-250	\$240.00
251 or more	\$330.00

* Where fees are payable under section 2 (in-flight music), no fees are payable under section 1 (music while on ground).
