Licence to communicate music to the public by non-commercial radio signals via the Internet (for example, campus radio)

Quick Facts

Licence period:
one year (Jan. to Dec.)

Annual Fee:
1.9% of gross internet operating costs, less discount for non-audio page impressions

Deadline:
Jan. 31 of the licensed year (music report form and payment)

Note: "Non-commercial radio stations" includes any station that is non-profit or not-for-profit, whether or not any part of its operating expenses is funded by advertising (e.g. campus radio stations).

Licence fee calculation

1.9% of gross Internet operating costs, times the ratio of audio page impressions to all page impressions if that ratio is provided to SOCAN, and 0.5% if not provided.

Stations that include gross Internet operating costs in calculating payments under Tariff 1B are not required to pay under Tariff 22C.
