Quick Facts

Licence period:

annual (Jan. to Dec.)
quarterly (Jan. to Mar., Apr. to Jun., Jul. to Sep., Oct. to Dec.)

Annual Fee:

percentage of site's internet-related revenues

Deadline:

annual: no later than 30 days after the end of the licensed year
quarterly: only applicable when licence fee exceeds \$350; due no later than 30 days after the end of each quarter

Music Licence Form:

socan.ca/form/22F

Note: This tariff is applicable to any audio website with music that is available in the territory of Canada.

Excludes sites subject to any other section of Tariff 22.

Licence fee calculation

1.5% if SOCAN's repertoire use is 20% or less. 4.2% if it is between 20% and 80%. 5.3% if it is 80% or more. Min. fees and discounts apply.

Internet related revenue means all revenues generated by Internet-related activities, including membership, subscription and other access fees, advertising, product placement, promotion, sponsorship, net revenues from the sale of goods or services and commissions on third-party transactions.
