SKATING RINKS

Licence to publicly perform live or recorded music in connection with roller or ice skating**

Quick Facts

Licence period:
one year (Jan. to Dec.)

Annual fee:
1.2% of annual gross receipts from admissions*
(\$111.92 min. fee)

Deadline:
Jan. 31 of the licensed year
(music licence form and payment)

Music Licence Form:

*Annual gross receipts from admissions are net of sales and any applicable taxes.

**Does not apply to figure skating lessons.

Licence fee calculation

The licence fee calculation is based on the previous year's gross receipts or an estimate if no music was performed in the previous year.

- Where admission is charged: 1.2% of gross receipts from admissions exclusive of applicable taxes; min. fee of \$111.92
- Where no admission is charged: annual fee of \$111.92

EXAMPLE 1:

A skating rink has gross receipts from admission of \$15,000 per year.

Fee: $\$15,000 \times 1.2\% = \$180 + \text{taxes}$

EXAMPLE 2:

A Community arena hosts public skating and does not charge admission.

Fee where no admission is charged = $\$111.92 + \text{taxes}$
